The Priesthood of All Believers

And coming to Him as to a living stone which has been rejected by men, but is choice and precious in the sight of God, you also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 2:4-5 NASB).

Under the old covenant, only the Levites could serve as priests. Priests had two functions: (1) they offered up sacrifices in worship, and (2) they were to “to teach the sons of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken to them through Moses” (Lev. 10:11).

Under the new covenant, however, every Christian shares in the priesthood. Every Christian has the responsibility to worship and to teach others the unsearchable riches of Christ. “But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellences of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. Once you were not a people, but now you are God’s people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy” (1 Pet. 2:9-10 ESV).

There are souls all around your neighborhood that needs the gospel of Jesus Christ, and God has asked every Christian to be involved in proclaiming the excellences of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

An Exercise Program with Eternal Value

Well, we're up at the crack of dawn, doing our exercises. We've trimmed the fat from our diet and we're exercising at least three to five days a week in order to keep our cardiovascular system in peak condition.

But in the process, we've allowed our spiritual heart to become progressively weak.

Preoccupied with the temporary, we've neglected the eternal. Have nothing to do with godless myths and old wives' tales; rather, train yourself to be godly. ⁸For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come. ⁹This is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance.. (1 Timothy 4:7-9) (Hebrews 5:14). But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.

We seldom read our Bible anymore. Our prayers have become lists of requests to God to make our life more comfortable and pain-free.

By the time we reach the church door after the sermon has concluded on the Lord's Day, we can't even recall what the preacher said, because we're thinking about some future worldly event or activity.

If the above thoughts describe us, perhaps it's time to go to the Lord's Clinic and get a "heart "evaluation.

It begins where David (a man after God's own heart) was in Psalm 139 — by acknowledging that God knows all about our heart. Read (Psalm 139:1-12). It continues in Psalm 51:10, where David asks, "Create in me a clean heart, O God. And renew a steadfast spirit within me."

And it results in the prayer of Psalm 19:14 "Let The meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer."

Brethren and friends, taking care of our body makes a lot of sense, but it makes even more sense to gain spiritual fitness by daily walking with the Lord. Read (Psalm 116:1-9;) But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.(1 John 1:7).

For that's an exercise program with eternal value!

Let's think about it!
