#### THE PROGRESSION OF SIN

Nations do not fall into a state of moral decay overnight: a definite progression of sin can nearly always be observed. This progression may be seen in four distinct stages:

SHOCK: The first reaction of decent folks to ungodly behavior is one of SHOCK. People simply can't believe what their eyes are seeing and their ears are hearing. We don't have to think back very many years to remember some things that don't raise an eyebrow nowadays which would have shocked the general public only a few short years ago! Shortly before they went into captivity, God

said of His people Israel, through the prophet Jeremiah, "Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? Nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush" (Jeremiah 6:15).

TOLERATION: When God's Word is not honored, shock gives way to TOLERATION. We still may not like something, but after the initial shock wears off, we put up with it! When God's Word is not held up as the standard to determine right from wrong, who is to say what's right or wrong? We don't want to be labeled bigots, so we swallow hard and keep our mouths shut. However, God does not overlook sin (Acts 17:30-31)

ACCEPTANCE: Toleration will soon be replaced by ACCEPTANCE. The majority approves of that which once was unacceptable. At this stage, we may not even realize a change in values has occurred. Passages like Romans 1:21 indicate that approval of sin puts one into the same category as those who practice such sins!

PARTICIPATION: The final stage is PARTICIPATION. After all, if you can't lick 'em, you may as well join 'em, right? Behavior that was before repulsive, becomes an accepted lifestyle. Did it happen that way to Sodom and Gomorrah? Stop and think a minute: how far the USA has fallen in the last few decades! What stage are we now in? (I'll give you a clue: it probably isn't the first one!)

We read in Daniel 2:21 that God sets up kings and removes kings. That applies to presidents and governors as well. God still rules in heaven and on earth! However, if we want to be an exalted nation, we must determine to be a righteous nation. We must return to God before it is too late.

"Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord" (Psalms 33:12).

## The rest of the Story

The Bible can change not only a life but also an entire lifestyle. Most of us have heard the story of the Mutiny on the Bounty, but few of us have heard how the Bible played a very vital part in that historical event. The Bounty was a British ship which set sail from England in 1787, bound for the South Seas. The idea was that those on board would spend some time among the islands, transplanting fruit-bearing and food-bearing trees, and doing other things to make some of the islands more habitable. After ten months of voyage, the Bounty arrived safely at its destination, and for six months the officers and the crew gave themselves to the duties placed upon them by their government. When the special task was completed, however, and the order came to embark again, the sailors rebelled. They had formed strong attachments for the native girls, and the climate and the ease of the South Sea island life was much to their liking. The result was mutiny on the Bounty, and the sailors placed Captain Bligh and a few loyal men adrift in an open boat. Captain Bligh, in an almost miraculous fashion, survived the ordeal, was rescued, and eventually arrived home in London to tell his story. An expedition was launched to punish the mutineers, and in due time fourteen of them were captured and paid the penalty under British law .But nine of the men had gone to another distant island. There they formed a colony. Perhaps there has never been a more degraded and debauched social life than that of that colony. They learned to distill whiskey from a native plant, and the whiskey, as usual, along with other habits, led to their ruin. Disease and murder took the lives of all the native men and all but one of the white men named Alexander Smith. He found himself the only man on an island, surrounded by a crowd of women and half-breed children. Alexander Smith found a Bible among the possessions of a dead sailor. The Book was new to him. He had never read it before. He sat down and read it through. He believed it and he began to appropriate it. He wanted others to share in the benefits of this book, so he taught classes to the women and the children, as he read to them and taught them the Scriptures as discovered. The people were living in decency, prosperity, harmony, and peace. There was nothing of crime, disease, immorality, insanity, or illiteracy. How was it accomplished? By reading, the believing, and the appropriating of the truth of God!
