

## Three Steps to Get to Heaven

Hell was not prepared for us. Matthew 25:41 says "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels," Heaven was prepared for us. It says in John14: 2-3 "My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am." Anyone who does the will of the Father can go there. Revelation 22:14 "Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city. " A journey to Heaven really only takes three steps. As we set our sights on the heavenly city, the first step we must make "out of self." Jesus told his disciples that if they would follow Him ,it would require self-denial; "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me" (Matthew 16:24). Once a person has taken this step, God will be placed at the top of his or her priority list. "But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." (Matthew 6:33). The next step for one to take towards Heaven is to step "into Christ." He is "The way" to heaven "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6). The only access to the Father is "through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God." (Romans 5:2). After the first step, this one is natural, but it is not completed until one has heard the Gospel, "Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ. (Romans 10:17), believed in Jesus, " (John 8:24), repented of all sin (Luke 13:3-5), confessed Christ's name, "(Romans 10:10), and been baptized to have all sin washed away (Acts22:16). Then, one must remain faithful to God until death (Revelation 2:10) to be ready to take the final step. The last step on the journey to Heaven is the step "into glory." Paul said, "That the flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God: nor does corruption inherit incorruption" (1 Corinthians 15:50). In this step we will be transformed from physical beings into spiritual ones. This will happen either upon our physical death or the return of Christ. Then there will be a Judgement, "Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment, (Hebrews 9:27). What a scene it will be! All nations will be gathered together and then separated. The righteous will be set on the Shepard's right hand, and the unrighteous will be on the left hand. For the disobedient it will be a terrible day. They will be sent away to everlasting punishment. For those who have taken the correct steps it will be a great day. They shall inherit the kingdom that was prepared for them. (Matthew 25:31-46).

If you want to go to Heaven, then remember the three steps to get you there.
