

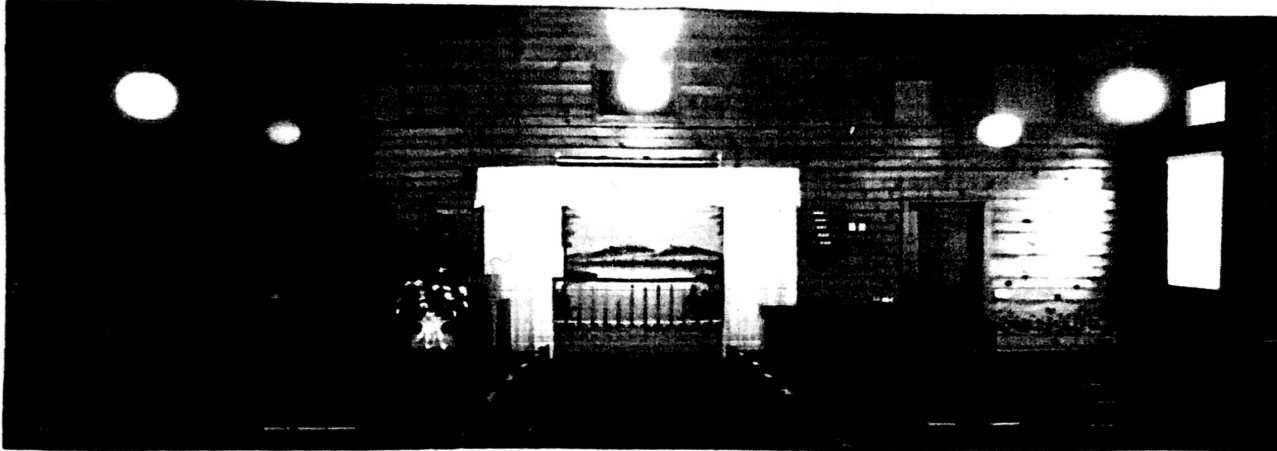

Three Things You Won't Hear in Heaven

The concept of a coming Day of Judgment is not a fantasy or fable. It is a fact.
